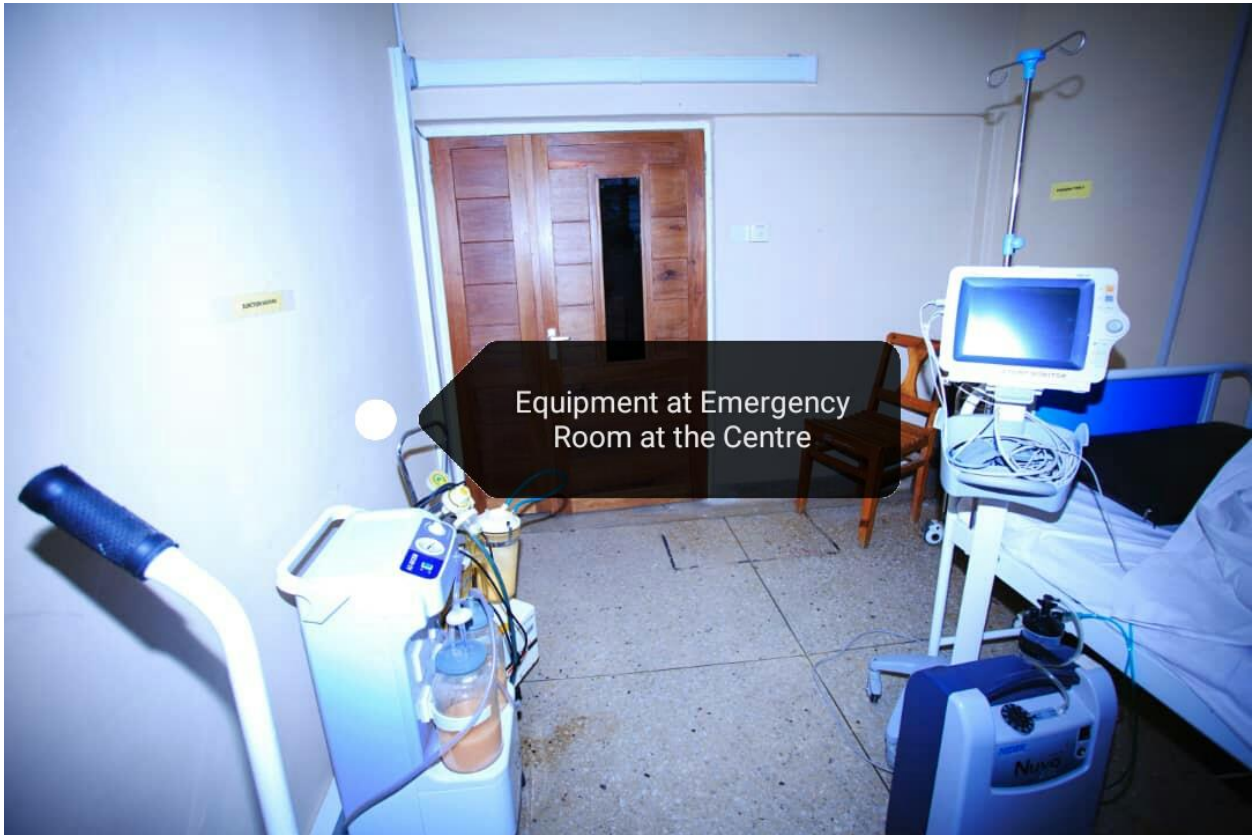
Facilities for COVID 19

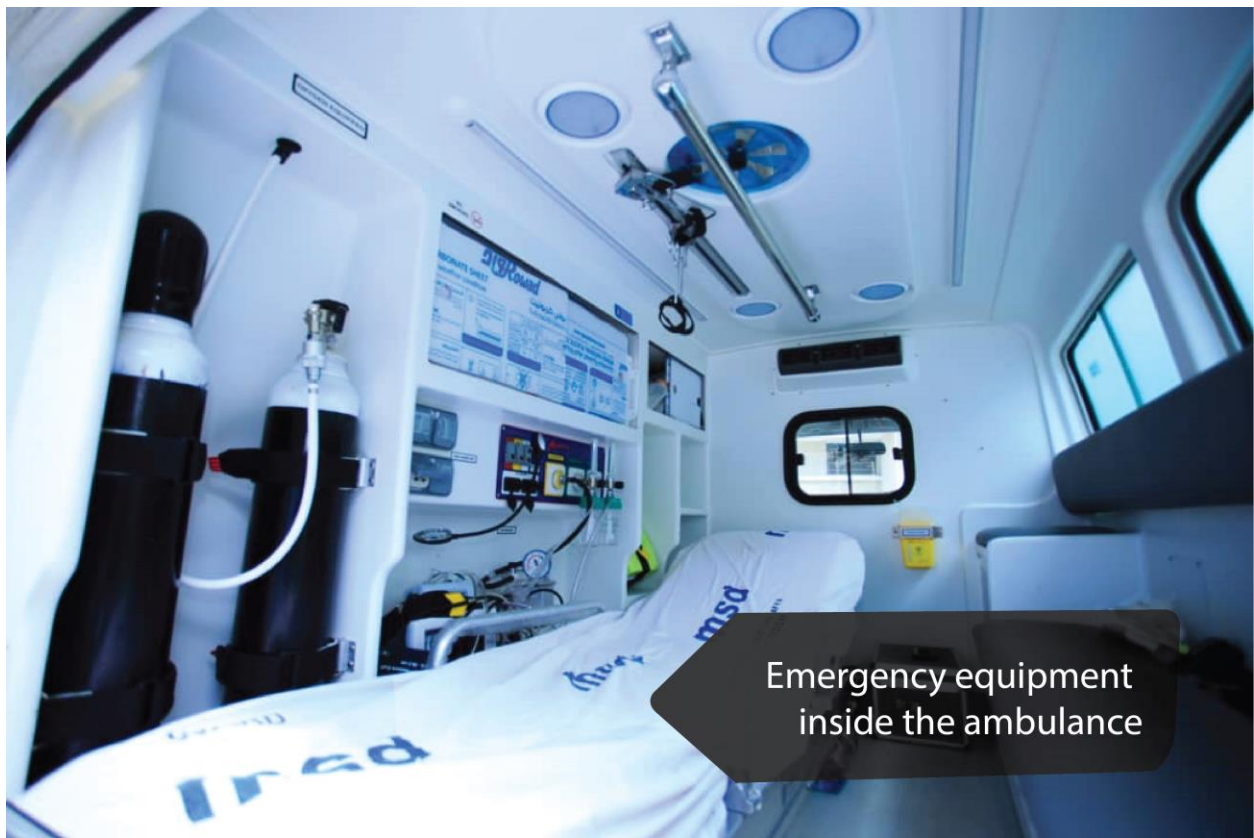
Client screen for Covid -19 before entering health centre building

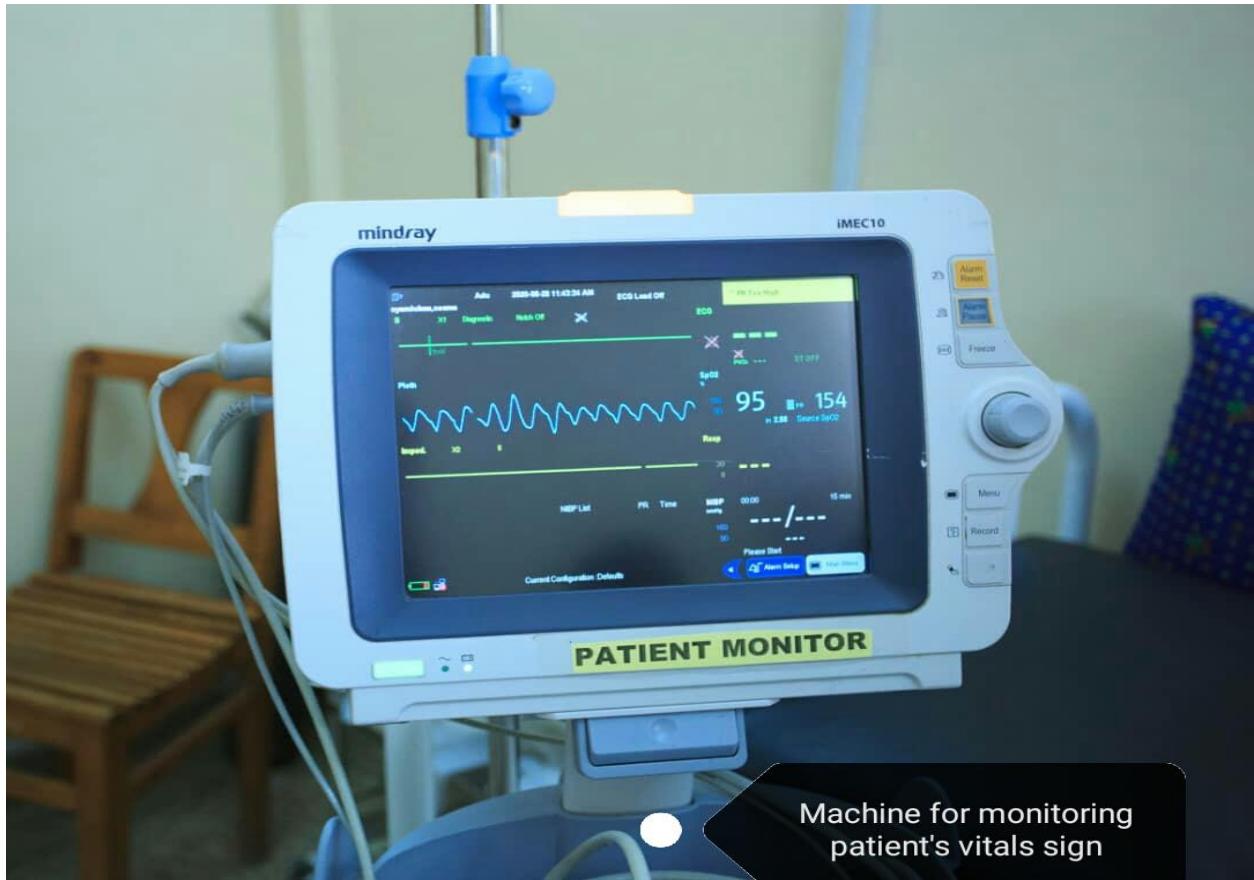


Equipment at Emergency Room at the Centre
