ADMISSION INTO THE UDSM CONSTRUCTION INCUBATOR

INTRODUCTION

The University of Dar es Salaam is establishing the Construction Incubator to provide mentorship and training schemes to equip young engineering graduates with the necessary tools to operate as entrepreneurs. This initiative is meant to contribute to addressing the challenge of getting meaningful professional engagement facing university graduates in many fields as the number of young men and women graduating from colleges and universities is greater than the available job opportunities within the government and in the private sector.

ELIGIBILITY

The Construction Incubator is targeting university and college graduates in construction engineering and related field. Preference will be given to graduates who have completed their studies in the last three years. More weight will be given to those who are currently self employed or are showing great inclination towards self employment. Applicants must show evidence of such intentions.

MAIN AREAS OF FOCUS

The Construction Incubator will focus on design, construction and supervision of different types of projects. Examples of the projects and services include architectural design of structures, repairs of buildings (roofing, floor, doors, windows, walls etc), plumbing works, electrical works, air conditioning services, road works, landscaping, water supplies, furniture, ICT services, and such other related services.

MODUS OPERANDI

The incubatees will be primarily attached to University of Dar es Salaam Innovation and Entrepreneurship Centre (UDIEC). They will be connected to BICO for the practical work and expert supervision. They will also be enrolled in the SEAP program of the Engineers Registration Bureau (ERB) to facilitate registration at the end of the incubation.

DURATION

The duration of the incubation will be a maximum of three years. Early graduation is possible particularly where the objectives of the incubation have been realized.
