TEMPORARY CLOSURE

Like many other countries in the World, Tanzania is currently facing an outbreak of Corona virus (COVID-19). In the implementation of Government directives and advice aimed at preventing the spread of this disease, all student academic activities at the University of Dar es Salaam have been temporarily suspended and the University closed with effect from today Wednesday 18th March 2020 until further notice.

In view of the above, all students, of all academic programmes, who are currently on leave, are required to remain at home or where they happen to be, until they are advised to return to the University. All students who, for one reason or another, are still on any campus of the University are required to leave and go home by Friday 20th March 2020, and to remain there until when the University reopens.

All other activities of the University will continue as normal while observing the Government and University directives regarding the control of the spread of corona virus.
