IMPORTANT NOTICE ON POSTPONEMENT OF EXAMINATIONS

For a long time now, we have been facing serious challenges during special/supplementary examinations session. Students with too many special or/and supplementary examinations have been failing to effectively prepare for or write their examinations due to constraints in terms of time and unresolvable collisions in the Examination Timetable. Due to this, we have clear guidance from the Director of Undergraduate Studies. The same is hereby communicated as follows:

1. From this Academic Year (2022-2023), requests for postponement of examinations will not be granted **except under very exceptional circumstances.**
2. Even under the exceptional circumstances stated in 1 above, the Dean **WILL NOT** grant any request or requests which, either separately or in aggregate, will lead to postponement of more than three examinations per academic year, **regardless of the reason or reasons for postponement.**
3. A candidate who, **for any reason**, requests to postpone more than 3 examinations per academic year will be required **to postpone studies.**
4. In view of 1, 2 and 3 above, any request to postpone all semester examinations will be met with **an outright rejection.**

Students are advised to consult their academic advisors for proper guidance/advice before they attempt to postpone any examination.
