IMPORTANT NOTICE TO FIRST-YEAR POSTGRADUATE STUDENTS FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2023/2024

1.0 INCOMING STUDENTS

Congratulations to all newcomers! Welcome to the Dar es Salaam University College of Education, 2023/2024 intake! You are joining a long and storied academic journey and we are pleased to introduce you to the DUCE Community. The Dar es Salaam University College of Education (DUCE) is pleased to communicate the following important information to all first-year Postgraduate students for the 2023/2024 academic year.

1.1 Orientation Week

Orientation week will be conducted at the College from Monday 30th October to Friday 3rd November 2023. The College is located at Chang'ombe in Temeke Municipality, along Taifa Road, next to the Benjamin William Mkapa Stadium. The detailed package to get started at the University is found on the other attachment document available in your admission application account.

1.2 Fees and Other Expenses

- (i) Irrespective of nationality, Fees can be paid yearly or by semester and once paid are not refundable. Also, the College reserves the right to revise fees as may be appropriate but not retrospective.
- (ii) The amount of tuition fee payable to the College upon registration depends on whether or not you are a Tanzanian/non-Tanzanian and on your sought degree programme to register.
- (iii) No student is allowed to register for the current year and commence studies before paying the due tuition fees on your student fees account in full, together with the amount payable upon registration.
- (iv)A student may create a control number for tuition fees and other payments via his or her ARIS3 account.
- (v) After registration you will be issued with Student University Identity Card which will allow you to access College Services.

4.0 MEDICAL SERVICES

To access medical services at the College Dispensary, students are strongly advised to obtain health insurance coverage offered by the National Health Insurance Fund (NHIF) or other health insurance providers. The payment scheme at the College Dispensary is by CASH or HEALTH INSURANCE. Currently, we ONLY serve members under the National Health Insurance Fund (NHIF). The Directorate of Students Services (DSS) may be contacted on the logistics regarding NHIF services.

5.0 **REGISTRATION PROCESS**

The registration exercise will be handled in the Admission Office located in the Administration Building First Floor, Room No. 120. All First-year students must submit the following documents at the time of registration:

- i. Evidence of payment of the University fees and at least 50% of the annual tuition fee (or per semester);
- ii. Copies and the originals of transcripts and certificates. [The originals will be returned to the student after physical verification];
- iii. Postgraduate Diploma Transcript and University Certificate (for students whose GPA for a Bachelor's Degree is below minimum entry qualification i.e. below 2.7);
- iv. Bachelor's Degree Academic Transcript (GPA must be above 2.7);
- v. Bachelor Degree University Certificate;
- vi. Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education (ACSE);
- vii. Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE);
- viii. Birth Certificate;, and
- ix. Two Colored passport-size photographs (Blue background).

Candidates who have acquired their academic awards and studied outside Tanzania must CERTIFY their academic transcripts and certificates through the Tanzania Commission for Universities (TCU) before they are allowed for Full registration. 5.1 Semester Registration

All postgraduate students must ensure that they register timely in the first three weeks after the commencement of the respective semester, failure to do so shall be liable for a penalty of TZS 5000 per day. No late registrations will be accepted after the fourth week of classes.

5.2 Maximum Period of Registration

- (i) The maximum period of registration for a Postgraduate Diploma shall be three years for full-time and four years for part-time students.
- (ii) The maximum period of registration for a Master's degree shall be four years for full-time and five years for part-time students.
- (iii) A candidate who fails to complete the study programme within the maximum period of registration without strong reasons shall be discontinued from studies.
- (iv) A candidate who is discontinued from studies for the reason of expiration of the maximum registration period shall be informed in writing about such discontinuation.

5.3 Extension of Studies

Candidates who, for valid reasons, fail to complete their theses/ dissertations within the specified period may apply for an extension of the study period under the conditions stipulated in regulation number 1.5.13. Extension of studies for postgraduate students (Masters) is done through ARIS3.

5.4 Postponement of Studies

Postponement of studies shall mean stopping studies for a semester of a full academic year where the period will count into the student's registration period, and it shall not be entertained. However, under special circumstances, permission to postpone studies may be considered as per regulation 1.5.13 for students during the coursework phase. Students wishing to postpone studies will be required to fill out the UDSM/PG.F13 form downloadable from https://www.udsm.ac.tz/web/index.php/directorates/dpgs/student-forms.

5.5 Freezing of Studies

Freezing of studies shall mean stopping studies for a specified period where the period will not count into the student's registration period. Students in the thesis and dissertation phase shall be required to freeze registration as per regulations 1.5.15 and will be required to fill out the UDSM/PG.F14 form downloadable from https://www.udsm.ac.tz/web/index.php/directorates/dpgs/student-forms.
