Join us for the Agripreneurship Summer School in Berlin in September 2024!





The Center for Banking and Financial Services Research of the University of Dar es Salaam Business School in collaboration with the Centre for Entrepreneurship at Technical University Berlin is offering an intensive and interactive Agripreneurship Summer School at Technical University Berlin, Germany from 2-13th September, 2024. The summer school is part of the Agripreneurship Education for Sustainable Development in East Africa (AESDEA) project funded by the German Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ) through the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD).

Aim: To empower UDSM postgraduate students to develop innovative and sustainable business ideas in agriculture.

Mode of delivery: The Summer School will be in person (at TU Berlin) and will involve interactive and practical learning with various inputs from experienced business coaches, practitioners, and startups in Germany. On the last day of the Summer School, there will be a Pitch Event whereby students present their business ideas.

Eligibility: You must be a postgraduate student at UDSM interested in agripreneurship, and passionate about developing a business idea. Students who have already participated in AESDEA's Summer School in 2023 cannot apply for this program. Preference is given to students without startup ideas, as the goal of the program is to develop new ideas in international teams.

Sponsorship coverage:

-  air ticket to and from Germany;
-  accommodation;
-  local transport ticket;
-  insurance while in Germany.

Note:

- i) Students are required to at least have Tsh 600,000 as their food allowance while in Berlin;
- ii) students should own a passport by the time of application.
