DAR ES SALAAM MERIT SCHOLARSHIPS FOR THE
ACADEMIC YEAR 2025/2026**

The University of Dar es Salaam is pleased to announce 3 merit-based scholarships for postgraduate students (at the Master's Level) for the 2025/2026 academic year. Successful candidates will register for studies at either the University of Dar es Salaam and/or her constituent's colleges (the Dar es Salaam University College of Education [DUCE] and Mkwawa University College of Education [MUCE]).

POSTGRADUATE MERIT SCHOLARSHIP

1. ELIGIBILITY

a. Application Requirements

The applicant must meet programme specific admission requirements as found in the Postgraduate Prospectus 2024/2025 on the UDSM website. In addition, the applicant must:

- i. Be a citizen of Tanzania,
- ii. Be a graduate of the University of Dar es Salaam,
- iii. Have obtained admission to an appropriate Master's programme,
- iv. Be not older than 30 years at the time of application,
- v. Be prepared to accept duties as a postgraduate teaching assistant,
- vi. Have completed his/her first degree within two years at the time of scholarship application, and
- vii. Have an undergraduate degree GPA of 3.8 (on a 5 - point scale) or higher.

b. Required Application Documents

- i. Copies of Secondary education certificates for both the 'O' and 'A' levels (pdf),
- ii. Copy of birth certificate or National ID (pdf).
- iii. Copies of university degree certificate and transcript (pdf),

- iv. A copy of birth certificate (pdf),
- v. One recommendation letter from person's familiar with your academic achievements, character and personality, and
- vi. A one-page motivation letter.

c. How to apply

Applicants must submit applications online in admission portal.

d. Scope of Scholarship

The scholarship will cover tuition fee, stipend, books and stationery aswell as research costs as stipulated in the University of Dar es Salaam Fee structure.

e. General Conditions

The merit scholarship shall not be held concurrently with any other award to support the beneficiary for the same academic programme. Applications for the merit scholarships will be open from **3rd November 2025 to 12th November 2025**. Selection and awarding outcomes will be communicated within four weeks after the application deadline.

It is an offence to submit false information when applying for scholarship. Applicants discovered to have submitted forged [certificates or any other falsified information will not be considered and appropriate legal action will be taken against them.
