In case you missed it, submissions are now being accepted for the Global Resilience Challenge's "Water Window" for up to US\$1m in scaling-up and seed grants to teams offering innovative solutions to issues affecting flood prone communities across the Sahel, the Horn of Africa, and South and Southeast Asia.

This is a great opportunity to receive funding for projects that offer innovative solutions to the very real issues affecting flood prone communities.

Entrants will need to complete a Concept Note and submit it online before the **8th May deadline**. Finalists will be announced at the end of August 2016 and invited to submit a detailed proposal. Finalists will receive mentoring from Global Resilience Partnership technical experts to refine their proposals.

The Water Window is backed by a US\$10 million commitment from the Z Zurich Foundation, as part of their investment in a global flood resilience program. It is set to fund teams of social entrepreneurs, community-based organizations, research, academic institutions, and international non-profit organizations and private sector organisations.
