The Vice Chancellor of the University of Dar es Salaam, Professor Rwekaza S. Mukandala wishes to inform the University of Dar es Salaam (UDSM) community and the general public that, the Acting Chancellor Ambassador Nicholas A. Kuhanga, in exercise of the powers vested upon him under Article 9 (1) of the University of Dar es Salaam Charter 2007, as read together with rule 6 (1) and (2) of the University of Dar es Salaam Rules 2007, has made the following appointments, with effect from 5th December 2014.

Prof. Florens D.A.M. Luoga, Deputy Vice Chancellor – Academic.



Prof. Luoga (born in 1958) is a professional lawyer. He has a Bachelor of Laws (LL.B. Hons) from the University of Dar es Salaam (1985); LL.M. from Queen's University (Canada, 1988); Master of International Law (MIL) from Lund University (Sweden, 1991); and PhD in Law from the University of Warwick (UK, 2003).

He was employed by UDSM as Tutorial Assistant in the then Faculty of Law (now University of Dar es Salaam School of Law) in 1986; he then promoted to Associate Professor in 2005. He has held various administrative posts at UDSM, including the following: Chairman of the Legal Aid Committee of the then Faculty of Law (1993–1995); Associate Dean – Administration, Faculty of Law (1992–1996, 2003); Director of Undergraduate Studies (2005–2009), University Corporate Counsel and Secretary to Council (2009–2013); and Acting Deputy Vice Chancellor – Research and Knowledge Exchange (2013 to date). Besides, Prof. Luoga is an advocate of the High Court of Tanzania.

Prof. Luoga researches and publishes widely in the areas of taxation, human rights, law and procurement.
