CALL FORPAPERS

The 2022 ACOSCM conference relates strongly to the DAAD-sponsored Centre of Excellence "SCO: Sustainable Operations for Resource Management and Food Supply" at the Universities of Nairobi and Dar-es-Salaam, and thereby sets the overall and important theme of sustainability for the conference.

The 4th ACOSCM complements previous conferences as it addresses relevant issues related to sustainability in its broadest sense.

Conference Participants

The conference participants will be predominantly researchers, but also policy makers and practitioners who will discuss and debate a wide range of issues on sustainability reevant to Africa. The African and international academic community will discuss sustainability in health and supply chains, policy, regulation, governance, and implementation as well as agricultural supply chains. In addition, the platform will provide an opportunity to deliberate on transport, logistics and supply chain management, besides other cross-cutting issues.
