- 2. Applicants should have a GPA of 3.5 or above on a five-grade scale in their first degrees.
- 3. Applicants should not be more than 35 years old as of November 2022.
- 4. The applicants should be Tanzanians.

Procedures

- Applications for scholarship should be submitted in electronic form or hard copy to the contact provided in this advertisement by providing application letter, detailed curriculum vitae, certified copies of Bachelor Degree Certificate (with TCU certification for degrees obtained from abroad), academic transcript, birth certificate (or passport), and two recommendation letters.
- 2. Applicant must also apply for admission separately by following the application procedures as indicated in the UDSM website.
- 3. Applicants should state in the application for admission that; they are applying for Master of Science in Petroleum Engineering by Coursework and Dissertation under the UDSM-Equinor Scholarship Scheme.

Deadline for Application

The deadline for application is 30th August, 2022. Interviews for shortlisted candidates will be conducted at the University of Dar es Salaam on a date to be communicated later. The MSc programme commences in November 2022.
